Celebrate the start of the school year with First Day of School keepsakes! These keepsakes help mark the occasion while giving children a chance to reflect on their experience.

With the First Day of School sign, your child can fill in their age, grade, teacher's name, and something special about their first day. Take a photo of your child holding the sign to capture the moment and start a yearly tradition!

Help your child fill out the certificate and "I Did It!" page after school and celebrate their completion of their first day! You can hang the certificate on the fridge or save it in a memory box.



Keep in Mind

- **Make it a moment.** Take a few quiet minutes after school to complete the “I Did It!” page together. Ask your child to share a favorite part of their day or something new they noticed.
- **Start a tradition.** Fill the keepsakes out each year to watch how your child grows and changes over time!
- **Support expression.** For younger children, write down what they say for the sign and “I Did It!” page. For older kids, encourage them to write or draw on their own.
- **Start early, if helpful.** Some families find it helpful to complete the top parts (name, grade, teacher, etc.) a day or two before school starts to build excitement and familiarity.
