


Roll Me a Story


Your child's imagination will be on a roll when they create the dice, toss them, and make up a story using the icons they land on.

Let your child choose how to create the story inspired by the prompts. They might act it out with toys, draw it, tell it out loud,



or write it down and illustrate it. They might want to keep it short and sweet or make it long and involved. There's no right or wrong way for them to "complete" the activity.

Just encourage them to have fun and let their imaginations run wild!



Keep in Mind

- This activity encourages creativity, language development, and independent thinking—all through play.
- You can keep the ideas flowing by asking open-ended questions like "What happens next?" or "How could you make this story really silly/happy/spooky?" to stretch their thinking and storytelling skills.





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Story Dice-Who?

Assembly Instructions

1. Cut along the solid lines.


