

# Let's Explore with HOMER at Home: Cars, Trains, and Airplanes

## Learning Connections

Recycling boxes! Use an old box that is no longer needed as a real life vehicle for play time! Let them decorate the outside with materials of choice and then let them pretend to be the driver, pilot, or captain! Ask them questions like what sound does their vehicle make, where are they going and what are they “driving” on. Let your child's imagination run wild, the stories are endless.
